God brings good out of the bad for those who love Him (Ro 8:28). This Bible verse has really been tested the past six months for those who were affected by the tragic Hill Country flood on July 4th. On our nation's birthday, paradise was lost along with 119 lives, during the catastrophic "500-Year" historic flood on the Guadalupe River. Another 20 souls drown in nearby rivers that day. It is hard to image that any good can come from a disaster like this, but with God all things are possible (Mt. 19:26). As the flood waters receded, I believe the Holy Spirit instructed me to:

1. Create a permanent limestone block memorial wall at The Coming King Sculpture Garden. The rugged, undulating "Hill Country Flood Memorial Wall" would face the Guadalupe River to the south and symbolize the raging river.
2. Create a large bronze plaque naming the Guadalupe River victims and documenting the history. Hundreds of other plaques would honor the victims and the organizations that came to our aid. Ministry plaques would share healing Bible verses and point to Jesus.
3. Create a life-size bronze sculpture of Jesus Christ walking on water, holding the hands of two smiling 8-year-old girls to be placed near the limestone wall.
4. Create a larger-than-life, monumental bronze sculpture of a Bald Eagle (Isa 40:31) rising from turbulent waters symbolizing hope. This patriotic sculpture will be placed at the entrance of the proposed TCKF visitor center, visible from IH-10. TCKF is seeking donations now to create the monumental sculpture and build the architecturally dynamic "King's Welcome Center". Working drawings are being created now in faith.

MORE GOOD...

The north side of the limestone wall will be called the "Believer's Wall Of Faith". It will honor Christian individuals, families, churches, ministries and companies. In addition, I designed the "Dwelling Place Of The Dove Memorial Garden" behind the wall. This secluded columbarium garden, within sight of the 77'7" cross, has black granite niches for the ashes remains of two TCKF supporters who want their last act of devotion to fund God's garden, so others might know Jesus.

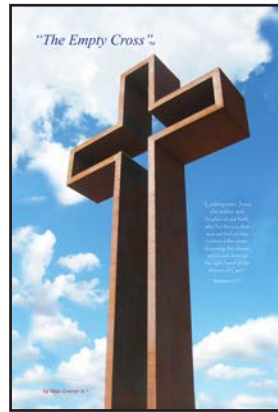
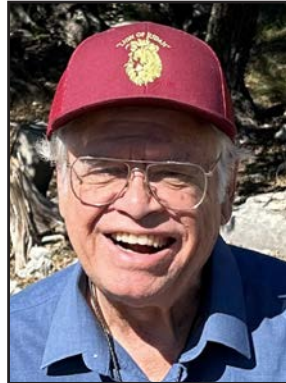

Resin Sculptures

Resin Sculptures are cast from molds. They maintain the precise detail of the artist's original carving. They are much less expensive than bronze or pewter, since they are not metal. Resin sculptures are cast from a special polyester epoxy material. This substance is often referred to as Bonded Bronze or Cold-cast Bronze, when bronze powder is mixed in.

Greiner's resin sculptures are finished to look like bronze. They are often mounted to a walnut or marble base. Resins weigh less than metal sculptures and are breakable.

They are not intended for outdoor display.

Because Max's compositions honor God, they carry His message and anointing. No matter the size, price or material, Greiner art is treasured for years!

Pewter Sculptures

Pewter Sculptures are metal, primarily made from tin, mixed with zinc, bismuth, copper and antimony. The "Sand-casting" and "Lost-wax" Casting process dates back to the Egyptians, Greeks, Romans and Chinese.

Pewter casting arrived in North America with the colonists at Jamestown, in 1610. The most famous American Pewter Smith was Paul Revere. The artist made the historic midnight, horseback ride to Lexington in 1775, at the beginning of the American Revolution. He famously warned: *"The British are coming!"*

Max started using lead-free Pewter to cast his small *"Divine Servant"*® sculptures in 1990. The white metal has the ability to capture precise detail. Less expensive than bronze, pewter is very durable and perfect for casting small sculptures, jewelry and medallions.

Bronze Sculptures

Bronze has been the choice of sculptors for thousands of years because of its durability, beauty, precise detail and reproduction ability. The Bible says that the first person filled with the Holy Spirit was the artist, Bezalel (Ex 31:1). Bezalel created the Ark Of The Covenant for Moses, after leaving Egypt. God still calls artists to make art today.

The ancient, lost-wax process is still used by art foundries. Bronze primary consists of copper and tin, with Zinc and silicon included. Original sculptures are normally made from clay or wax. They are supported by a metal armature, or foam interior. The labor-intensive casting process takes three to six months, depending on the size and complexity of the original carving.

Bronze ingots are melted at 2000 degrees and then poured into special ceramic molds. After cooling, the castings are cleaned (chased) and welded together, to match the original sculpture. Finally, chemicals are used with heat to create a beautiful finish (patina).

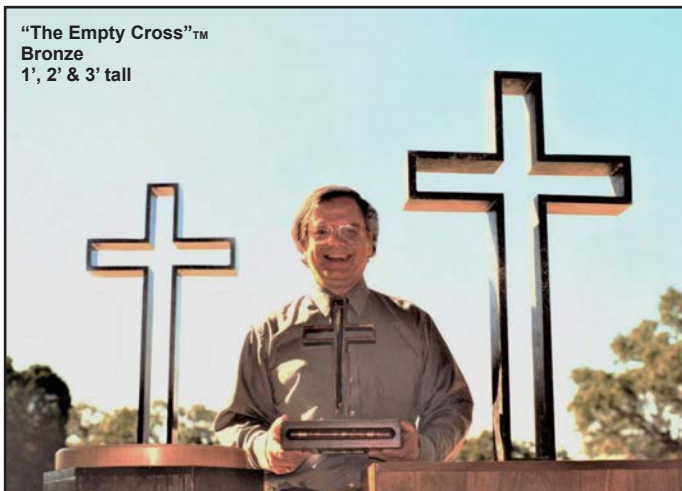
Max Greiner, Jr. created his first bronze sculpture of white-tailed deer in 1978. In 1986, God called Max to make art for His Kingdom. After a two-year season of disobedience, the artist finally yielded to God and created a 1/6 life-size sculpture, "Divine Servant"®, in 1989. Today, Greiner's largest bronze sculpture is the life-size, 18' tall "The Coming King"® statue.

Cor-Ten Steel

Cor-ten Steel, also known as "Weathering Steel", is used for Greiner's largest sculptures of "The Empty Cross". This unique steel acquires a permanent, dark blood-red patina after being exposed to the elements. This eliminates the need for painting in the future.

Greiner's unique cross has a Carbon Steel "skeleton" under the Cor-ten Steel "skin". It appears to "bleed", after "scouring". This cross symbolizes the Open Door, Way, Light, Strong Tower, the Mighty Fortress and Resurrection.

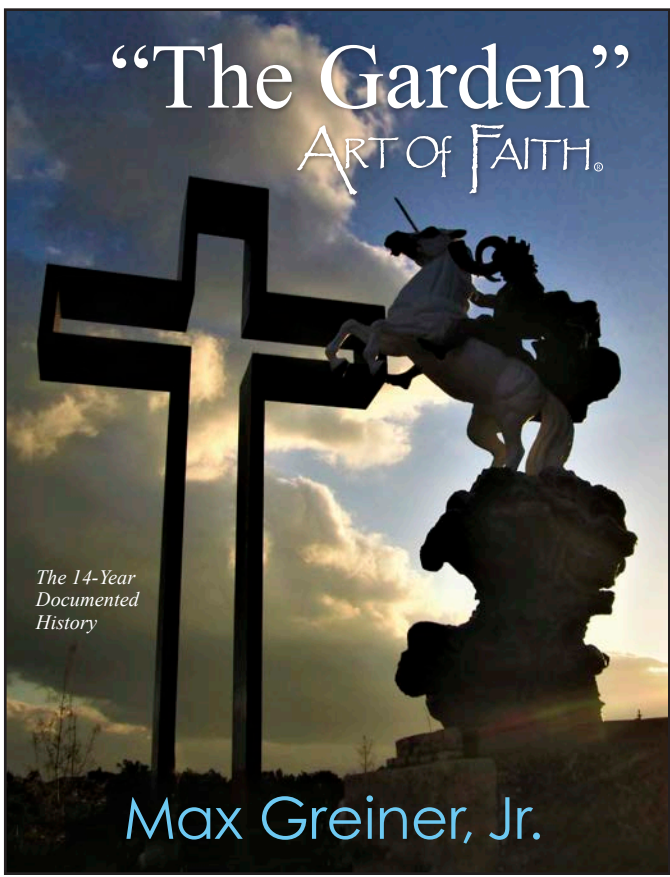

Create Your Own Sacred Space!

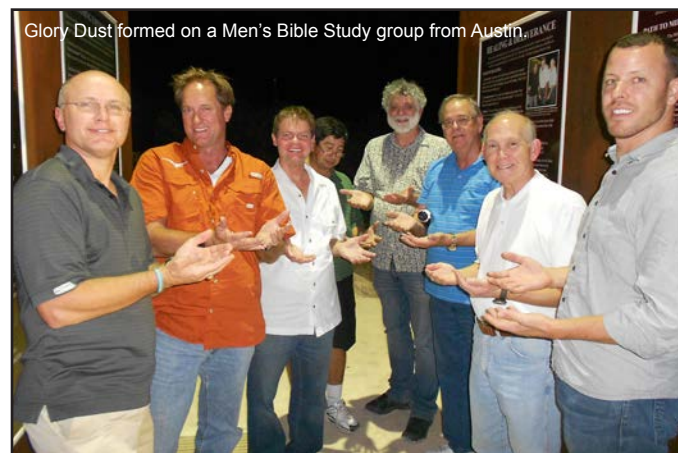

Holy ground can be created indoors or outdoors. Greiner's architectural consultation is free to those who purchase his monumental sculptures.

"Covenant Certified" TCKF Gardens

If you would like to create a large sculpture prayer garden to bring glory and souls to Jesus, consider building a "Covenant Certified" Garden, according to the 2002 vision given to the artist. This evangelistic plan literally draws passersby off the highway, so they might find the love of Jesus. Unique to other methods, this "Strategic Eye-gate Evangelism" (SEE) uses the "eye" to reach the "heart"!

On December 9, 2001, God called Max and Sherry Greiner to establish free, soul-winning, Tabernacles across the USA and world. On May 6, 2004, the couple formed THE COMING KING FOUNDATION, a non-profit, 501(c)3 "Art Museum", to assist others desiring to build a "Covenant Certified" Garden. These free non-denominational art parks can be self-funded, and income generating.

The first prototype "Covenant Certified" Garden art park was built on IH-10 in Kerrville, TX. Over a million people have now visited the free, tourist attraction. Open 365 days a year, TRIP ADVISOR designated the Kerrville art park in the top 10% of attractions worldwide! Because of large visitor numbers, commercial "pad-sites" can be sold or leased near the garden, to cover expenses and generate income for Christian developers, churches, colleges and ministries. If developers commit to building a "Covenant Certified" Garden, according to God's plan, the Greiners will donate "The Empty Cross", Cor-ten steel sculpture (in any size) at the actual foundry cost, so glory and souls can come to Jesus!
